- 11 The Blue goalie has both his feet in his own crease.

The count starts.  
A Red attacker checks the Blue goalie's stick. The ball is still under the Blue goalie's stick, inside the crease.  
**A LEGAL PLAY BY THE RED ATTACKER.**
- 12 The Blue goalie has both his feet in his own crease.  
He covers the ball, which is outside the crease, and is about to pick the ball up.  
A Red attacker checks the Blue goalie's stick. The ball is still under the Blue goalie's stick, outside the crease.  
**A LEGAL PLAY BY THE RED ATTACKER.**
- 13 A Blue defender, not the goalie, has both his feet in his own crease.  
He covers the ball, which is inside the crease, and is about to pick the ball up.  
A Red attacker checks the Blue defender's stick. The ball is still under the Blue defender's stick, inside the crease.  
**A LEGAL PLAY BY THE RED ATTACKER.**
- 14 The Red goalie has both feet outside his crease.  
The ball is on the ground, inside his crease.

The Red goalie reaches into the crease, covers the ball, and begins to rake the ball towards him.  
The ball is still in the crease when the Red goalie, still raking the ball, steps into the crease.

**A LEGAL PLAY BY THE RED GOALIE.**

15 The Red goalie is stranded out of his crease. A Red defender is standing on the goal-line. The ball is in the Red crease.  
The Red defender tries to pick up the ball, but the ball gets stuck in his stick. The whistle blows.

**RED BALL 20 YARDS Laterally from the cage.**

16 Red attacking and a flag is down. A Red shot hits the post.

The ball bounces out and hits a Blue defender, not the goalie, who is inside the crease. The ball enters the goal.

**GOAL.**

17 The Blue Goalie has been given a 1-minute penalty. He has not exchanged his stick with another player.

Another Blue Goalie has come onto the field, carrying a goalie's stick.

When the "original" Goalie's penalty time is over, he steps onto the field carrying his goalie's stick.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY BLUE.**

18 The Red goalie comes out of his crease to play a loose ball.

The ball becomes stuck in the Red goalie's stick. He is still outside his crease.

**RED BALL 20 YARDS (18.29 METRES) Laterally from the cage.**

19 The Red Head Coach asked for a stick-check in the first quarter. The stick was illegal.

The Red Head Coach asked for a stick-count in the second quarter. Blue had 5 long sticks on the field.

The Red Head Coach asked for a stick-check in the third quarter. The stick was legal.

The Red Head Coach asks for a stick-count in the fourth quarter. Blue have 4 long sticks on the field.

**THE LAST REQUEST (IN THE FOURTH QUARTER) IS A TECHNICAL FOUL BY THE RED COACH.**

20 A sudden-death overtime period ends with the ball loose.

**THE NEXT SUDDEN-DEATH OVERTIME PERIOD STARTS WITH A CENTRE FACE-OFF.**

21 At a centre face-off, the Red face-off man has his right foot to the right of the throat of his crosse.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY THE RED FACE-OFF MAN.**

22 At a centre face-off, the Red face-off man is touching the centre-line with his left foot, as the whistle blows to start the play.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY THE RED FACE-OFF MAN.**

23 At a centre face-off, "Set" has been called. The Red face-off man moves his left foot.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY THE RED FACE-OFF MAN.**

24 At a centre face-off, there is no Red player in the penalty box, but Red have only 9 men on the field of play.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY RED.**

25 After a centre face-off, a loose ball technical foul is committed by Red, before "Possession" or "Free Ball" are called.

The ball is awarded to Blue in their defensive half.

Red #5, who lined up for the face-off in Red's attack goal area, drops back into the "central zone", to ride the Blue player.

**TECHNICAL FOUL BY RED.**

- 26 After a centre face-off, a Referee mistakenly blows his whistle before "Possession" or "Free Ball" are called.  
**FACE-OFF WHERE THE BALL WAS WHEN THE WHISTLE BLEW. ALL PLAYERS RELEASED IMMEDIATELY.**
- 27 The ball is dead. Red have a time-out left. Red's Assistant Coach requests a time-out.  
**RED'S REQUEST IS LEGAL.**
- 28 The ball is dead. Red's Assistant Coach requests a stick-count.  
**RED'S REQUEST IS LEGAL.**
- 29 A stick has a wooden shaft. The end of the shaft is not plugged and it is not taped.  
**THE STICK IS ILLEGAL.**
- 30 Red attacking and a flag is down. Red drop the ball. The whistle blows.  
Blue have a time-out left in the half. The Blue Head Coach asks for a time-out.  
**THE TIME-OUT REQUEST IS LEGAL.**
- 31 A goalie is in possession of the ball in his own crease. He brings back his crosse, in order to clear.  
The ball crosses the plane of the goal.  
**THE GOAL COUNTS.**
- 32 Blue #5 passes to Blue #6. As the ball is in the air between the two players, a referee mistakenly blows his whistle.  
**THE BALL IS FACED-OFF.**
- 33 Red #6 is in the penalty box, serving a 30-second penalty. He returns to the field of play. Red score.  
Before the next face-off, the CBO tells you that Red #6 came on too soon and that it was the fault of the time-keeper.  
**THE GOAL COUNTS.**
- 34 Red #6 is in the penalty box, serving a 30-second penalty. He returns to the field of play. Blue score.  
Before the next face-off, the CBO tells you that Red #6 came on too soon and that it was the fault of Red #6.  
**RED #6's ORIGINAL PENALTY IS CANCELLED BY THE GOAL, BUT HE MUST STILL SERVE 30 SECONDS FOR COMING ON TOO SOON.**
- 35 Red #6 is in the penalty box. He returns to the field of play. Red score.  
After the next face-off, the CBO tells you that Red #6 came on too soon and that it was the fault of Red #6.  
**THE GOAL COUNTS. RED #6 STAYS IN THE GAME.**
- 36 A sudden-death overtime period ends with the Red goalie in possession in his own crease.  
**THE NEXT SUDDEN-DEATH OVERTIME PERIOD STARTS WITH RED IN POSSESSION 20 YARDS (18.29 METRES) FROM THE RED CAGE.**
- 37 A Red shot has gone out-of-bounds directly behind the Blue goal.  
**THE BALL PUT BACK INTO PLAY DIRECTLY BEHIND THE BLUE GOAL, EVEN THOUGH THIS IS FEWER THAN 20 YARDS (18.29 METRES) FROM THE CAGE.**
- 38 A shot misses the goal and stops on the field of play, behind the goal.  
Blue #5 tries to pick it up, but it goes out of bounds.  
**RED BALL.**
- 39 A shot misses the goal and is rolling towards the end-line, behind the goal.  
Blue #5 tries to pick it up, but it goes out of bounds.

**THE BALL IS AWARDED TO THE NEAREST IN-BOUNDS PLAYER.**

- 40 Red #5, for tactical reasons, delays his re-entry to the field of play after his penalty has been served.  
**TECHNICAL FOUL BY RED #5.**
- 41 The ball bounces up in front of the Red goal. Blue #5 bats at the ball and directs it so that it enters the Red goal.  
Before the ball crosses the goal line, Blue #5's stick collides with the Red goalie's stick.  
The crosses collide inside the cylinder.  
**GOAL.**
- 42 The ball bounces up in front of the Red goal. Blue #5 bats at the ball and directs it so that it enters the Red goal.  
Before the ball crosses the goal line, Blue #5's stick collides with the Red goalie's stick.  
The crosses collide outside the cylinder.  
**GOAL.**
- 43 The Red goalie has the ball in his possession inside his own crease.  
He leaves the crease but is legally body-checked back into the crease by Blue #5. The Red goalie still has possession of the ball.  
**TECHNICAL FOUL BY THE RED GOALIE.**
- 44 Red #5 and Blue #6 are fighting for a loose ball near a boundary.  
The ball touches Red #5's stick and rolls towards the boundary.  
Blue #6 traps Red #5's stick under his own stick and the ball rolls out-of-bounds.  
When it goes out-of-bounds, the ball is fewer than 3 yards, (2.74 metres) from Red #5's stick.  
**THE BALL IS AWARDED TO BLUE.**
- 45 Blue score a goal. The CBO informs you that both teams were off-side.  
**NO GOAL. FACE-OFF 20 YARDS (18.29 METRES) FROM THE CAGE.**
- 46 Blue attacking. Red #5 goes off-side. Realising his mistake, Red #5 goes "back on side". A flag is thrown.  
Red #5 then drops back into defence, thus "going off-side again". Blue fail to score.  
**RED #5 SERVES 2 TECHNICAL PENALTIES FOR BEING OFF-SIDE TWICE IN THE SAME PLAY.**
- 47 Blue #5 has committed three personal fouls, each of them worth 2 minutes.  
**BLUE #5 IS FOULED OUT OF THE GAME, AS HE HAS HAD 6 MINUTES OF PERSONAL FOULS.**
- 48 Red #5 has been fouled out of the game. His last foul was worth 2 minutes.  
**A SUBSTITUTE IS ALLOWED FOR RED #5 AFTER 2 MINUTES HAVE ELAPSED.**
- 49 Viewed from the timers' table, the Blue bench is on the right-hand side.  
Blue #5 spends the last 5 seconds of his penalty time on one knee on the left-hand side of the gate.  
**TECHNICAL FOUL BY BLUE #5.**
- 50 Blue #5 slashes and a flag is thrown. Blue #5 then holds and a second flag is thrown.  
Red fail to score and Blue #5 is sent off for 90 seconds.  
Red score 15 seconds into Blue #5's penalties.  
**BLUE #5 HAS 45 SECONDS LEFT TO SERVE AFTER THE GOAL IS SCORED.**

- 51 A Red defender, not the goalie, has both of his feet inside his own crease.

R2 tells you that he blew for a stalling offence by Red.
- Mistake by R2. Red ball.
